BOOK-A-RIDE How It Works

1. Register or Book a Ride

Please give as much notice as possible.

For safety, passengers must be able to get in and out of the vehicle independently. Foldable walkers and wheelchairs can be accommodated if they fit in a standard vehicle. Please inquire about driving children.

2. Confirmation

Registering and returning patients will receive confirmation details by email from a dispatcher.

3. Driver Coordination

A driver from your area will be assigned to you. They will contact you directly to confirm pickup time and conduct a brief health-safety check.
